Hall of Fame Award

This award recognizes **Outstanding Lifetime Achievement** of Canadians in **Science Fiction and Fantasy**. It is awarded to Writers, Artists, Musicians, Fans, and others who have made great contributions to the genre.

About the Trophy

This beautiful award trophy was sculpted by Vancouver artist Gideon Hay. The two back-to-back faces represent facets of Janus, the Roman God of doorways, decisions, and beginnings and endings. One face looks to the future, as much of Science Fiction always has, and the other to the past, which is the home of most of Fantasy.



The female face is timeless, a homage to the sub-genre of Time Travel. She wears a retro space helmet, referencing the traditional role of Space in **Science Fiction**, and also giving a bow to the popular sub-genres of Steam Punk and Alternate History.



The male face represents **Fantasy** with elements of Bacchus, Loki and the Green Man in his secretive, ironic smile. He wears the Knight's helmet of Classical Fantasy. His wild face reminds us not only of the myths and legends that underlie all literature but also of dark fantasy and its eldritch children.

Get Involved!

Any Canadian can nominate a deserving person for the **Hall of Fame** by joining CSFFA (\$10/year) and submitting a nomination form. The final decision is made by a jury. Deadline for 2015 nominations is July 1, 2015.

CSFFA also administers the national **Aurora Awards** for best SF & F Writer, Artist, etc. You can both nominate and vote for the Aurora Awards by joining CSFFA.
